UNM Student Laptops come **as is**, with standard software already installed.

Windows laptops include: Office365 (including Outlook & Teams), Zoom, Mersive, Microsoft Edge, and Respondus (lockdown browser/lockdown browser ALEKS).

MacBooks include: Microsoft Office 365 (including Outlook & Teams), Safari, Siri, Zoom, Adobe Creative Suite, and Respondus (lockdown browser/lockdown browser ALEKS).

If you need additional applications, you may only download them from these sources:

- **Microsoft Company Portal* (Windows)**
- **Jamf Self Service* (Mac)**
- **Lobo Virtual Desktop* (Windows and Mac)**

Downloading and installing software from anywhere else is restricted due to licensing.

To use Google services, Adobe Digital Editions, Autodesk, Unity and Unreal, it will require students to login to a free personal account from these vendors.

Company Portal is an application installed on Windows laptops.

How to access:

1. In the Search window enter "**Company Portal**" or
2. Press the **Command (Windows) Key** and the **Space Bar** to open the search window.
3. Login and authenticate with your **UNM Net ID** and **password**.

If you cannot find Company Portal, it can be downloaded and installed from the **Microsoft Store**.

How to request access:

UNM checked out devices must go to Company Portal or Self Service, to install the Omnissa Horizon Client. The link provided in the email is intended for personally owned devices.

2. **Important Note:**
 - **Do not** use the link in the access email. Instead, download **Omnissa Horizon** from:
 - **Company Portal** for **(Windows)**
 - **Self Service** for **(Mac)**
3. In the access email, refer to steps 2,3, and 4 to add the server.
